COACHES VIEW

Round 3 Preview

Firstly, how good is it just to have some live rugby back at Bridgehaugh. It was great to see so many familiar faces at our first match a couple of weeks ago and we hope to see many more over the course of the season. After a couple of false starts and motivation understandably dwindling within the player group, wondering when we would get back, it's been brilliant to see the excitement grow and see exactly how much it means for these guys to be wearing the County jersey once more.

Recruitment was tough, trying to get the balance between homegrown players who were ready to play Super6 and young players who just needed to stay and play club rugby week in week out. There's been some good news stories with the likes of George Breese, Callum Cruickshank and Craig Robertson stepping up from the Wolves and bringing Archie Russell back to the club. In the end, we are really happy with the final blend of our 32-man squad; 60% of the squad has been retained from season 1 and 40% played youth rugby at Stirling County.

The season so far has been a challenging one with a tale of near misses. We have had some really good spells within both matches, our defence has been outstanding, and we've shown a real clinical edge at times. We now need to improve our accuracy in attack and our discipline to ensure we are defending less and creating more opportunities to score. The boys continue to work really hard and have shown great appetite to improve so I am confident a more complete performance is just around the corner.

Heriots are in a similar boat. They came up just short against the Bears away from home in round 1, where their ill-discipline cost them, and then left themselves too much to do against a quality Knights side last Sunday. They will be hurting after such a loss in their first home match and I am sure they will come to Bridgehaugh desperate to pick up their first win and stop us from doing the same in the process.

Today's match will be our first outing to be shown live on Freesports. It's huge for the competition to have two matches a week broadcast live and I know the players are looking forward to the occasion. Both sides like to play an exciting brand of rugby so hopefully the weather allows, and we get another cracking game of rugby at Bridgehaugh – where would you rather be.
