The Wolves next Tennents National 1 fixture is away against Watsonians next Saturday. The Women's team plays Corstorphine at home on the 24th of October. Like the Women's team, the Wolves Second XV doesn't have a fixture this weekend and play Marr in the West Reserve Division 1, on Saturday 23rd of October, at Bridgehaugh.
