Welcome, all to Bridgehaugh to the eleventh fixture of the Tennents National 1 League game.

Today we extend a warm welcome to Bridgehaugh to all visitors, sponsors, former players, and members, along with a special welcome to our opponents from Melrose. Melrose Rugby is the name of the amateur rugby team, and we welcome both President, Douglas Brown and his colleagues to this rearranged Friday evening fixture at Bridgehaugh.

However, having lost the first five fixtures, albeit, by narrow margins against the likes of Biggar and Heriots Blues, there is hope that this was just a blip and so we look forward to an improved performance from the squad. Melrose Rugby will be desperate to win this game, so let's hope for a cracker of a game, and may the best team win.

Our Women's team lost their Friday evening fixture game against Cartha Queens Park 32-20 win, and the Wolves Second XV moved to second place in the West Reserve Division 1 league beating Cartha 33-19 at Bridgehaugh. The Women's team plays Hillhead Jordanhill at Bridgehaugh on Sunday 14th November with a 2.00 pm kick-off. This weekend the Wolves Second XV play don't have a fixture in the West Reserve league.

The Wolves next Tennents National 1 fixture is at home on Friday 19th November against Highland RFC, the Women's team play Heriots Blues away on Sunday 21 November, and the Wolves Second XV play Ayr/Millbrae at Bridgehaugh on Saturday 27th November
