I extend a warm welcome to Bridgehaugh to all visitors, sponsors, and members, along with a special welcome to today's opponents Ayr, and their President Drew Young and his colleagues.

#### Super6

Ravaged by injuries and the unavailability of key players the Wolves lost their last fixture 66-7 to Watsonians. This was a big change from the result in the final game of the Sprint Series, played at Meggetland where Watsonians won with a last gasp interception try, with a final score of 24-21. The injuries have really skewed the results for the squad, and we all hope that they can bounce back against today's visitors the Ayrshire Bulls. However, this will not be an easy feat as the Bulls played Glasgow Warriors last week, up in Inverness. Performing admirably, fighting back from 22-3 behind to score two converted tries in the final ten minutes, with a final score of 22-17. During the Sprint Series the Wolves beat the Bulls 27-26 at Bridgehaugh in May after lost 33-24 down at Millbrae in April. The next FOSROC S6 Championship fixture is against Watsonians, at Bridgehaugh, on Friday 23rd September, with a 7.45pm kick off.

#### 1st XV

County's pre-season preparation has prepared them well for what looks to be a very competitive league, judging by the results in the first round. Remembering the team lost their first five fixtures last season and dabbled with relegation on a couple of occasions. The first XV started the league with an excellent 20-7 win against Melrose, whereas Ayr lost 26-17 to Highland up in Inverness. This is always a hard fixture for travelling teams, so they will be looking to bounce back today. Last season County were beaten both home and away so they will have to be on their guard. The fixture against Watsonians last week was cancelled and will now be played on 19th November at Myreside. Next week they travel to play Aberdeen Grammar up at Rubislaw which should be another hard game.

#### 2nd XV

The Second XV played GHA, winners of last season's reserve league, and were beaten 21-13 in a very close game. This very young squad

will once again be looking to repeat last season results where they came second in the Division One West Reserve League. The next fixture is on 24th September, away to GHK at Anniesland.

Our County Women's Team started off the season with an emphatic 54-17 win, against Hillhead-Jordanhill, on Sunday 21st August. They are away to Garioch RFC today, in the Premiership. Their next fixture is on Saturday 24th September, at home, against Heriot's Blues, with a 1.00 pm kick off.
