Welcome, to Bridgehaugh to the fourth fixture of the Tennents National League game.

Today we extend a warm welcome from Bridgehaugh to all our visitors, sponsors, former players, and members, along with a special welcome to our opponents Dundee Rugby and their President Derek Black.

Dundee has started the league losing their first three games, a 35-22 loss to Highland during an away game, and 18-17 to Biggar. Last week they played top of the table Gala at Mayfield and lost 41-17. This means that they will be hungry for their first win, so County be aware.

The first XV started the league well, winning 20-7 against Melrose at Bridgehaugh, however the 18-10 loss to Ayr at home last week showed that there is a lot of work to do and the close, but very welcome 25-24 result last week up at Rubislaw, against Aberdeen Grammar illustrates this very well. This should be a hard match, and County will have to raise their game to secure an important home win. Their next fixture is away to GHK, on 8th October, at Anniesland with a 3.00pm kick off.

Our women's team are currently sitting top of the premiership table and having won all three games, 54-17 against Hillhead Jordanhill and beating table topping Watsonians 17-14 at Myreside. Last week they hosted Cartha Queens Park, with another great 44-5 win, at Bridgehaugh. Their fixture today is against Heriot's Blues who beat Watsonians 17-12 last Saturday. Their next fixture is against Corstorphine, at Bridgehaugh on 8th October with a 2.00 pm kick off.

The Second XV played GHA, winners of last season's reserve league, in their first game and were beaten 21-13, followed by a 17-7 defeat to Ayr/Millbrae. Last Friday evening they won away to GHK at Anniesland, under lights 51-15. Next week they play Cartha Queens Park at home with a 3.00pm kick off.

Our next FOSROC Super6 Championship fixture is an away game against the Ayrshire Bulls at Millbrae on Friday 7th October with a 7.45pm kick off.


