PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Welcome, all, to this evening's fixture and the last home game of round 7 of the FOSROC Super6 Championship.

Today we extend a warm welcome to Bridgehaugh to all visitors, sponsors, former players, and members, along with a special welcome to our opponents from Edinburgh, Watsonians. Watsonians represent the S6 semi-pro side playing in the FOSROC Super6 Championship.

This is a top versus bottom game, with Watsonians sitting top of the championship table after winning 5 games and amassing 26 points. The Wolves are clearly anchored to the bottom of the table having had a "tempus horriblus", due to injuries which have depleted the squad over this seven-week period. The last fixture, on the 3rd of September, between the two sides, at Myreside resulted in a 66-7 win for Watsonians, in a match which reflects the current league position the Wolves find themselves in. This contrasts with the sprint series, where the matches were a lot closer and more competitive.

The Wolves played the Ayrshire Bulls last week, racking up a 66-4 loss, whereas Watsonians played the Boroughmuir Bears, winning the match 31-10. Last week's first-half performance, well 30 minutes of it showed promise, however, this fell apart as too many first-up tackles were missed and too many mistakes were made during this half resulting in the final score, outlined above. We can only hope that the squad can play for the 80 minutes and make this last home fixture one to remember. Next week they play Boroughmuir Bears, at Meggetland, on Friday evening, with a 7.45 pm kick-off.

Best wishes from the club go to Logan Trotter, who recently signed for London Irish, and made his debut on Wednesday evening against Harlequins in the English Premiership. I've known Logan since he started with County in the mini P4's, and he's an excellent example of a player who has come through the club and U20 international pathway. Our congratulations go to Logan, and I am sure he will prosper in the professional environment that London Irish will provide him with.

1ST XV

County's game against Ayr last week brought the 1st XV squad back to earth after the fine 20-7 win against Melrose. Ayr played the game smarter and were better at the basics and were deserved 18-10 winners. County travel up to play Aberdeen Grammar up at Rubislaw, who sit second bottom of the table, having lost 34-12 to table-topping Gala. This will be a hard game as, no doubt, Grammar will be looking at their home advantage to pull themselves up the table. Next week they play Dundee Rugby at home, with a 3.00 pm kick-off.

2ND XV

The 2nd XV played Ayr last week in the Division One West Reserve League, where they lost 17-5. This is a young squad, and they will learn from the first two hard games and start to improve as the season goes on. Their fixture this Saturday is away to GHK at Anniesland. Next week they play Cartha Queens Park at home, with a 3.00 pm kick-off.

Our County Women's Team started off the season with an emphatic 54-17 win, against Hillhead-Jordanhill, in the Premiership, on Sunday 21st August, and then winning 17-14 against Watsonian FC, at Myreside on 3rd September. Their next fixture is tomorrow, Saturday 24th September, at home, against Cartha Queens Park, with a 2.00 pm kick-off. Next week they play Heriot's Blues away, at Goldenacre, with a 1.00 pm kick-off.

COACHES' VIEW

Tonight's match is our last at Bridgehaugh in what has been a very disappointing Championship so far. Several factors have meant we have had no consistency in terms of training or selection, and this has resulted in some really disjointed performances on match day too. To give an idea of the challenges, we have used 45 players in the first 6 Rounds of the competition. Our registered squad is capped at 32 which has meant a need for a lot of emergency loan and permit players. Whilst in general these guys have slotted in well and have put their hand up to play, it's obviously a struggle trying to build cohesive partnerships when there are so many changes on a weekly basis.

However, in despite of what the results would suggest, we are starting to see some green shoots from this group. We are starting to get some of our more experienced guys back on the pitch and starting to see some of the combinations that worked so well through the Sprint Series.

There is no getting away from how disappointing the final scoreline was versus the Bulls last time. We gave the ball away far too cheaply in our half, our reaction to turnover wasn't good enough and we paid a heavy price with some clinical finishing from our opponents. However, for large spells, we were competitive. It's the most intensity we have shown, and we created some good opportunities ourselves. The challenge now is to replicate this for longer spells and ensure we start making teams work harder for their points.

The task doesn't get any easier this week against one of the form teams in the league and the reigning Sprint Series champions. However, we have had some great results versus Watsonians at Bridgehaugh in the past and we go into the match believing that if we stay in every moment and fight through every passage, we will give ourselves a chance of getting our first win of the season.
