Welcome, all to this eight fixture of the Tennent's National One League competition.

I extend a warm welcome to Bridgehaugh to all visitors, sponsors, and members. Along with a special welcome to today's opponents Highland RFC and their President Roy Dinnes, and his colleagues.

County have now lost four and won three games, losing 49-17 to Kelso, last week, sitting seventh on 13 points on the league table. Although they started the league well as highlighted in previous programmes the word inconsistency springs to mind. The squads is very young, with an average age of nineteen. Our County Women's Team started off the season with an emphatic 54-17 win, against Hillhead-Jordanhill, then picking up wins against Watsons, Heriots Blues and Cartha Queens Park. They then went down 27-20 to Corstorphine in a surprise defeat but bounced back, on Sunday 16th October, with 34-15 win against Hills away, and then with a 29-7 win away to Cartha Queens Park last week. Today they sit at the top of the Premiership League table and play Watsonians who sit one place below them. The next fixture is on 5th November, away to Garioch.
