PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Welcome all to this thirteenth fixture of the Tennent's National One League competition and to our Christmas lunch.

I extend a warm welcome to Bridgehaugh to all visitors, sponsors, and members, along with a special welcome to today's opponents Watsonians FC and their President Richard Kelly, and friends.

As has been mooted before this is a must-win game for both sides. County lost out last week 47 -13 to Melrose at the Greenyards, whilst Watsonians beat a plunging Gala 52-14 at Myreside. This reverses their previous loss of 32-10 at Netherdale. County was due to play Watsonians, on the evening of 18 November, but this was cancelled due to flooding. County now sits on 23 points, having now lost six and won five games, also losing heavily to Gala, at Netherdale, 55-17. Watsonians are a good rugby footballing side on their day but today sit on 16 points having lost 8 games and won 3, to date.

As commented before whilst the County squad is very young, with an average age of under twenty, they must start to learn and stop their mistakes. It was pleasing to see again the improvement in the set piece but too many mistakes in defence and a lack of control in the attack have meant they are not winning the games which are there for the taking. If they can maintain consistency in tactics and especially defence, they can beat anyone in the league.

Both teams have a game in hand, and they will play the last fixture of the league at Myreside on the 1st of April. Watsonians will be desperate for a win, so County be wary today and on guard.

May the best team win.

County's next fixture in Tennent's National One is away next Saturday 17th December, to Ayr, at Millbrae, with a 3.00pm kick-off.
