I extend a warm welcome to Bridgehaugh to all visitors, sponsors, and members, along with a special welcome to today's opponents Corstorphine RFC and their President Stewart Pilkington and colleagues.

Our County women's team sits at the top of the Tennent's Premiership Women League table, having played and beaten Heriot's Blues 28-5 last Saturday at Peffermill. Corstorphine RFC beat Watsonians RFC 17-0 the week before, so we now have the two best sides in the Tennent's Premiership contesting the playoffs.

County Head Coach Mark Ainsworth commented about the Heriot's Blues game: "It is an excellent result for us; credit Heriot's as they gave us a tough test and have improved dramatically. Mark Ainsworth commented on the final:

"We now play Corstorphine Cougars in the final at Bridgehaugh on Saturday in what should be a highly entertaining and tight final. I think it's only fitting that the two stand-out teams from the regular season are contesting the final, and the whole squad is looking forward to playing in front of our fantastic support at Bridgehaugh."
