#### **COACHES' VIEW**

Meanwhile, Wolves Head Coach Eddie Pollock was unapologetic about his team's uncompromising approach in a match that was already dead as a contest after 20 minutes.

"I've got a championship to win," he stated. "We're here to develop players but we're also here to win games. We need to get and keep our scrum and line-out functioning so that we're ready to face Watsonians next week, who are very strong there.

"It's a difficult one because we train hard every week to go out on a Saturday and score points, so we had to approach this game like we were playing Watsonians, Heriot's, or Ayrshire Bulls," he added.

"And we're a really physical side so it was a massive challenge for these Future XV boys, but they have to learn how to defend powerful mauls and scrums, and they'll get better for it. In the second half, we looked to play off the scrum more, and they played pretty well for a period.

"We got a lot of guys who haven't had much game-time over the last two games some minutes on the park, and we feel that we're now in a pretty good place in terms of guys being match-fit and not having too many injuries. We've also got nine points out of three games, so we're in the hunt, and we're looking forward to having Watsonians here next Friday which will be a big game."

Glenn started playing rugby at the age of 5 down at Alloa RFC, then moved to Stirling County Colts at the age of 12 playing all the way through to under 18s going on to win the Scottish Cup against Musselburgh in the final. He then moved up to the senior squad playing for the 2nd XV before moving up to the 1st XV.

Glenn represented Scotland at all age-grade levels under: 17s,18s,19s, and 20s and played in the Junior World Cup in Italy.

Glenn signed his first professional contract with Jersey RFC in 2009, then went on to win the National League 1 gaining promotion to the championship. He played in the championship season then left in 2012. He then went on to sign for Doncaster RFC in the 2013/2014 season where they went on to win The National League 1 to gain promotion to the championship. It was then he signed for Glasgow Warriors 2014/2016 winning the Rabo Pro 12 in his second season. He then signed for Edinburgh Rugby 2016/ 2018.

He was also part of the Scotland 7s 2015/2019, winning the first title at Twickenham beating South Africa. This was one of his greatest highlights! He then went back to Glasgow Warriors 2019/2021. He left in December 2021 to sign for the new franchise in Los Angeles called the LA Giltinis for the 2021 season. He went on to win the Major League Rugby title in his first year, Glenn mentioned it was a crazy amazing experience living over in the States and travelling all over playing rugby. He retired professionally after that season having been playing professional Rugby for over 10 years. He then decided he would be coming out of retirement. Glenn is really looking forward to pulling the County jersey back on & enjoying the season.

"This Championship we're finding out who we are as a team, We play a real exciting brand of rugby to watch & show what we are capable of when we get it right, but now we have gelled even more as a team, There's a real buzz about this squad in training leading into the championship season, Personally i am looking forward to wearing the jersey again!"
